## OPENER & CLOSER:

**Four ladies (men) promenade**, go walking around that ring, gonna get back home and give that man (girl) a **swing**. All join hands you know, you **circle left** and go, do an **allemande left** that corner, **weave that ring**. I feel like crying, sighing, what can I do. **Swing** that pretty lady and **promenade** her too. It's been a blue, blue day, I feel like running away; I feel like running away from the blues.

## FIGURE (twice for heads, twice for sides):

**1 & 3 (2 & 4) square thru**, four hands around you do, with the corner do a **dosado**. You're gonna **swing thru** friend, then do a **single hinge**, all **split circulate 2 spots**, **boys run** around this girl. **Reverse the flutter wheel** bring a new lady back across **and promenade** the ring. It's been a blue, blue day, I feel like running away; I feel like running away from the blues.

## MIDDLE BREAK:

Sides face **grand square**. It's been a blue, blue day, I feel like running away, I feel like running away from the blues. My love has been untrue, she's found somebody new. It's been a blue, blue day for me. **Four ladies chain across**, then **chain 'em** right back home. Turn that girl around and **promenade** along. It's been a blue, blue day, I feel like running away; I feel like running away from the blues.

TAG: (**Swing** her) I feel like running away from the blues.
