OPENER & CLOSER:

Sides face **grand square**. One day you'll look to see I've gone, but tomorrow may rain so I'll follow the sun. (**Allemande left** and **weave** the ring). Someday, you'll know I was the one. So tomorrow may rain so I'll follow the sun.

FIGURE (Twice for heads, twice for sides):

Heads (sides) square thru four hands round you will go. **Dosado, swing thru** today, **boy run** right. **Ferris wheel**, why don't the centers **pass thru**. **Touch a quarter, scoot back, swing** that guy **promenade**. For tomorrow may rain so I'll follow the sun.

MIDDLE BREAK:

And now the time has come and so my love I must go. And though I lose a friend, in the end you will know. (**Allemande left** and **weave**) One day, you'll look to see I've gone, but tomorrow may rain so I'll follow the sun.

TAG:

Yes, tomorrow may rain so I'll follow the sun.
