Figures (Twice for heads, twice for sides):

Heads (Sides) fan the top and then. **Ping pong circulate** and now **extend**. **Explode and load the boat** go movin' around you know. **Swing thru, acey deucey** there. **Boys run** right, **chain down the line** and **promenade**. You're always in my dreams and in my prayers.

Middle Break, Closer:

Sides face **grand square**. Kansas City lights. In my mind they shine so bright. She's waiting there; I've been away too long. **Allemande** and **weave** the ring. Kansas City lights. Shine for me tonight. Watch over her for me till I get home.
