Opener:

Sides face **Grand Square**. Every time I see a woman on a billboard sign I think about you. Saying, "drink this beer and you'll be mine" I think about you. **Allemande left** and **weave** the ring. When an actress on a movie screen plays Lolita in some old man's dream. It doesn't matter who she is; I think about you.

Figures (Twice for heads, twice for sides):

Heads **promenade halfway** round the ring you know. Come in and **star thru**, then **pass thru**. **Circle up four** go **halfway** around the ring. You **slide thru**, **pass thru**, and **bend the line**. **Square thru three** hands 'round, **swing** your corner girl and all **promenade**. It doesn't matter who she is; I think about you.

Middle Break and Closer:

(**Circle left**) I think about you, eight years old, big blue eyes and a heart of gold. **Left allemande** and **dosado**, the **men star left**, roll it one time 'round, **turn thru** at home, **allemande left** and **promenade**. When I look at this world I think about you.
